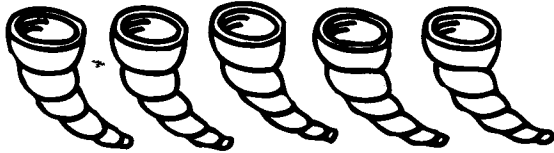
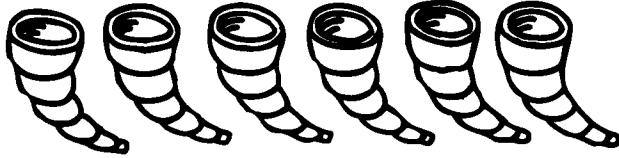
- Teacher cuts slits as shown on back of this page.

- Name some ways you can obey God.

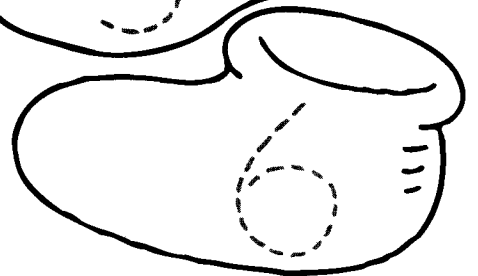
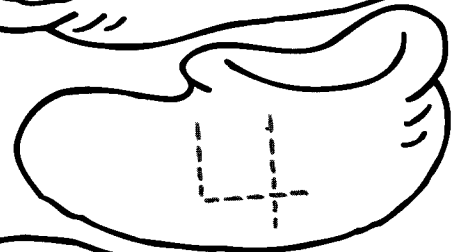
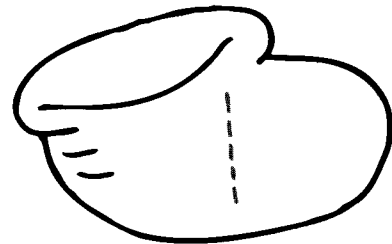
Roll page for easy
