Warm Up

1. If you could describe yourself when you were a teenager in three words, what would they be?
2. Take time to share a story from when you were a teenager that has shaped the person you are today.

Dig In

1. Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9.
2. Fearing the Lord is having an accurate understand of God and responding appropriately. What does fearing the Lord look like in your life? Has your concept of fearing the Lord changed with time?
3. God commands us to love him with our heart, soul and might (very). It was proposed that “might” could refer to our talents, possessions, wealth and family. Discuss how the local and global church is doing in fulfilling this command. What do you appreciate about how our church in Diamond Bar fulfills this command?
4. We live in a world with options, distractions and idols. We discussed last Sunday that our young people need to see us modeling God above all. How do you balance and explain to your kids the importance of placing God above all while the world preaches an opposite message? If you don't have kids, how do you reconcile these competing ideas?
5. Talk about some practical ways to model to our young people the teachings of God. When do you find the most success talking about God's teachings with your family? When is it most difficult? Why?

2. If you have children, when will you discuss with them the importance of placing God above all? How will you model this to them?
