Discussion Questions:

1. Read Matthew 5:4. How does mourning over your sin and experiencing God's comfort go together? Have you experienced comfort when you have mourned over your own sin? If so, please share about the experience.
2. Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-2. Paul urges the Corinthians to mourn over the sin of a believer in their congregation and to take steps to point him back to Christ. Why do we need to be reminded to mourn over the sin of other believers? What does our reaction tend to be when we see believers sinning?
3. Read Philippians 3:18-19. Paul has tears when he thinks about people who do not know Jesus. Why is it appropriate to mourn over the sin of people who do not know Jesus?
4. How might God be calling you to have a change of heart regarding sin in your life, the life of Christians, or in the world?
