

Discussion Questions
For Dangers and Deception of Temptation
Proverbs 5:1-23

1. As you start you study, ask each member to share a piece of wisdom that they remember their father or mother sharing with them when they were growing up:
Example: "Always carry food with you when you travel"
 - a. "Never take candy from a stranger"

2. What is the problem that the father is warning his son about in verses 3-6?

What are some other temptations that teens and adults face in our culture today?

3. Why do you think both men and women are vulnerable to moral temptations and sin?

Compare: "Lips / Speech" (5:23) / beauty / eyes (6:25) / Flattery (7:21)

4. What are some of the consequences of immoral living? (5:4-14)

Examples: Loss of Wealth (10) Loss of Health (11) Loss of Reputation (14)

Compare: Proverbs 6:24-25 & 7:10-23

5. How can you avoid getting drawn into temptation and moral sin? (Proverbs 5: 15-20)

Compare: Matthew 5:27-28 / I Corinthians 6:18-20 / 7:1-5 / II Timothy 2:22

6. What are some of the sobering consequences if you pursue moral sins?

7. Examples: Have to Face God (Proverbs 5:20 / Face an angry spouse (6:21-35) /

Face your own spouse / children / extended family / friends

8. What will you do this week to protect your marriage and moral life?

9. What words of warning and instruction will you share with your kids & grandkids?
