Ice Breaker: How do you like to celebrate your birthday?

1. Read 1 Corinthians 7:25-28. Paul affirms singleness as a good option for Christians. He also says that marriage is a valid option. Do you think that Christians today view marriage and singleness as equally acceptable? Please explain.

2. Read 1 Corinthians 7:29-31. Paul encourages Christians to live godly lives because this world is only temporary. What is one way that you could live differently by remembering that this world will pass away?

3. Read 1 Corinthians 7:32-35. Paul says that singles have the advantage of serving God with undivided devotion. What are some ways that singles can serve God that might be difficult or impossible for married people?

4. Many Christians will get married because they can serve God better in marriage than they could as a single. What are some ways that a person might be able to serve God better in marriage than they could as a single?

5. Read Matthew 12:46-50. Jesus greatly values his spiritual family. How do you go out of your way to value your Christian family? How can you value them more?
