Discussion Questions:

1. Share a memorable work-related experience/incident. This can be something from your distant past or recent history. It can be funny or serious.
2. If you are currently working, share one aspect of work that you enjoy and one aspect that could be improved. If you are not currently working but have worked in the past, share, recall an aspect that you enjoyed.
3. Read 1 Peter 2:18-20. Christians are called to have an attitude of submissive in the workplace. By having this attitude, what does this communicate to our supervisors at work? Is there ever a situation when we should not submit to our authority? Please share.
4. Read 1 Peter 2:21-23. In this passage, Peter focuses his discussion on Christ's suffering during his ministry on earth. How does Christ's suffering relate to us?
5. Read 1 Peter 2:24-25. In this passage, Peter focuses his discussion on Christ's death. What does Christ's death mean for us?
6. Read Matthew 6:33. According the Sunday's message, what does it mean to "seek first" the kingdom of God and His righteousness? If you are currently working, in what tangible way can you demonstrate this attitude this week at work?
