

The Pioneer of Salvation
Hebrews 2:10-18
March 8, 2020

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Hebrews 2:10-18. Jesus Christ, the “pioneer” of salvation, suffered and died on our behalf to give us the opportunity to have a lasting relationship with God. He suffered so that we would not have to suffer eternally. This does not mean that we won’t suffer temporarily (see Romans 8:16-17). Give an example of temporary suffering that a believer might experience.
2. What is the significance of verse 11, especially when it tells us that Jesus is “not ashamed to call them brothers”? What comfort does this bring us?
3. Verse 15 talks about the fear of death, which was a reality for those in the first century. Fear of any kind can be debilitating and paralyzing. Share an example of a fear that people might suffer from today. How can we encourage someone who is suffering from fear with the love of Jesus?
4. Between now and Easter (April 12), how can you demonstrate a tangible act of kindness and share the love of Jesus?
