Discussion Questions:

1. Read 1 John 2:1-2. What words or images come to mind when you hear the word *advocate*?
2. In verse 2, we are told that Jesus is the propitiation for our sins (i.e. he satisfied the demands of God's justice). Our sins (past, present, and future) have been paid for by the work on the cross. At times still, we must often face the practical consequences of our sins. What is an example of a practical consequence of sin?
3. Read 1 John 2:3-11. What does it mean to walk like Jesus? Share an example of a situation you face on a regular basis and what it would like to respond in a Christ-like manner.
4. Read 1 John 2:12-14. John addresses the three spiritual generations in the church. Why is it important to have all three spiritual generations coexisting in the church?
