Discussion Questions:

1. Read Philippians 2:1-8. The term “hypostatic union” describes the joining of the divine and the human in the one person Jesus. When it came to fulfilling his own needs and desires on earth, Jesus operated within the limitation of his humanity. Why is this important for us to know?
2. Read Matthew 22:36-40. This passage is not intended to be used to promote self-love. Instead, it reminds us of “our propensity for self-care and self-comfort” and calls us to transfer it willingly to others to care for and comfort them instead. How does this biblical principle differ from what our society tells us about loving ourselves?
3. Read Ephesians 4:32. The word “be” literally means “become” in the original Greek. We, as followers of Jesus Christ, are to become kind to one another. In other words, what we were not at one point, we are to become. This tells us that kindness does not come from within us. Why is it important to know this truth?
4. Read Galatians 5:22-24 and Titus 3:4-5. The Spirit of God empowers us to lead a Spirit-filled life. How will you put this into practice this week?
