Discussion Questions:

1. Read Galatians 5:22-23. The word “goodness” in verse 22 is translated from a Greek word which means “uprightness of heart and life.” In its immediate context, it refers to “selfless care for the benefit of others.” Why is it important to connect “goodness” and “others”?
2. Read Titus 3:4-6. Consider the following quote from C.S. Lewis, “The Christian does not think God will love us because we are good, but that God will make us good because he loves us.” What does this tell us about the goodness of the believer?
3. What obstacles make it difficult to demonstrate goodness to others? Feel free to refer to the Parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37.
4. What tangible expression of goodness can you demonstrate in the next few weeks?
