Discussion Questions

1. What are some ways that you find comfort and encouragement as you realize that God is all-knowing and knows everything about you? (Psalm 139:1-6) Compare: Matthew 6:8 / I Chronicles 28:9 / Jeremiah 17:9-10 / Proverbs 16:2)
2. How do you feel when you realize that God is all-present and that nothing you do or say can be hidden from Him? (Psalm 139:7-12). How can this also be encouraging? Compare these passages where God says, "I will be with you" (Joshua 1:8 / Psalm 23:5 / Isaiah 41:10 / Acts 18:9-10 / Hebrews 13:5-6)
3. We believe that God is directly involved in the creation of our lives (Psalm 139:13-18) Compare: Jeremiah 1:4 - How does this truth affect your view of Evolution / Abortion / Euthanasia / etc?
4. David begins and concludes this Psalm with the words "search me and know me" (Psalm 139: 1 & 23-24). Conclude your discussion by providing some quiet time for people to quietly reflect and apply these closing words to their own life.
