Discussion Questions:

1. Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-11. Members of the Corinthian Church were taking their cues from the culture around them in almost every area of life, including how they handled lawsuits. The Greeks were a very litigious people (i.e. unreasonably prone to go to the law to settle disputes). How might a litigious tendency negatively impact our overall Christian testimony?
2. Would anyone in your discussion group be willing to share a personal experience involving arbitration of some sort? What was the experience like? How did it impact you? Those around you? What did you learn?
3. When the Apostle Paul wanted to motivate his spiritual children to live a life worthy of their calling, his favorite appeal was essentially, "Let your actions match your identity." Why is it important for us to be reminded of our identity in Christ?
4. How can today's passage encourage us in our daily interactions with others?
