Discussion Questions

1. Food brings people together, which is why it is an important part of most celebrations. Share some of your favorite foods to eat and any favorite restaurants.
2. Read Galatians 2:11-21. "Relapse" is defined in the following ways...(a) to fall or slip back into a former state or practice, (b) to fall back into illness after apparent recovery, or (c) to fall back into vice. If you feel led to, please share a time when you experienced some form of relapse in your life.
3. How did Peter's actions in response to peer pressure (i.e. withdrawing from eating with Gentiles) negatively impact other Jewish Christians? What lessons can we learn from Peter's actions?
4. By position, we were sinners before Christ got a hold of our lives. After being justified (i.e. declared righteous by God), we were made saints by position. As "set apart ones," in what practical ways would you like to grow in your "sainthood" in light of Galatians 2:11-21?
