Discussion Questions

1. Read Psalm 15. The presence of God in the Old Testament was centralized in the Tabernacle (tent). When the people of God (the Israelites) wanted to experience God's presence, they would go to the Tabernacle. In your life, has there ever been a special place where you would go to "meet" God? If so, please share.
2. Read John 4:29-24. While many of us may go to a special place to meet God, we know that worship has more to do with "how" and not "where." Why is it important for our worship to come from our heart? What are some potential consequences if we simply "do" worship?
3. Read Psalm 15:3 again and then James 3:9-12. What kinds of danger can Christians run into if we are not careful with our tongue (think about your various relationship with others in the body of Christ)? What are some practical ways that we can guard our tongues?
4. According to Psalm 15, blamelessness is the requirement to enter into the presence of God. On our own, blamelessness is impossible. Only God's mercy (think about the Mercy Seat in the Tabernacle) makes it possible for us to encounter Him. In what ways have you experienced God's mercy in your life?
