1. Read Romans 12:10. The church in Rome was comprised of Jews and Gentiles who were experiencing tension with each other. Paul tells the church to love each other with "brotherly affection". What does this tell us about the way that God wants believers to treat each other, especially when we have different cultures from one another?
2. Read Romans 12:10 again. Paul tells us here to outdo each other in showing honor to one another. What makes it difficult for us to honor each other above ourselves like this verse urges?
3. Read Romans 12:15. Paul reminds us how important it is to "rejoice with those who rejoice" and to "weep with those who weep." Why is doing this important during a time like we are experiencing, when racial injustice is heavy on many people's hearts?
4. How do you sense God might be calling you to bring healing and hope during this season?
