Discussion Questions

1. Some claim that they worship Jesus, not the Bible. What pitfalls or faulty assumptions are connected to this statement? Is there any truth to be gleaned from it? Discuss and evaluate both its valid and invalid aspects, connecting your ideas to what the Bible says about itself.
2. No matter how much we study and learn about the Bible, we cannot understand God's truth apart from the power of the Holy Spirit. What is the difference between knowledge and truth? Share a time when God's Spirit revealed to you something from the Scriptures that you needed to learn.
3. If God speaks to us through Scripture, then we certainly need to read it. What are some practices or routines that have helped you to be diligent in reading and studying God's Word?
4. We must also accept the authority of Scripture. What are some areas where you find difficulty in accepting the authority of God's Word? Do you see any disconnects between creedal belief and practical application in your own life?
5. God calls us to meditate on His Word. What does it mean to really meditate on God's Word? How do we find space for this in our hectic lives?
