① **How did our time in the Word on Sunday help you to better understand Colossians 3:1-14?**

② **How does Colossians 3:1-14 remind us of who we are in Christ?**

- *What are the words & phrases that remind us of our position in Christ?*
- *Why is Paul (the author of Colossians) so concerned that Christians remember their position in Christ even as he tells them to die to sin?*

③ **According to Colossians 3:1-2, where does “putting off sin” begin?**

- *How do the two commands - seek & set - help us understand the process of dying to sin?*
- *What other passages in the Bible help us understand how to renew our minds?*
- *How do you know that God has changed your desires?*
- *What are some evidences that your mind is being renewed?*

④ **What does it mean to “put sin to death?”**

- *Is it actually possible this side of heaven to “put sin to death?” If so, how?*
- *How does Matthew 5:29-30 help in our understanding of putting sin to death?*
- *Why don't we put sin to death? We know God hates it. We know it comes with consequences? So why don't we actually kill sin?*

⑤ **How do you actually “put on Christ?”**

- *What does it actually look like to “walk by the Spirit and not fulfill the desires of the flesh?”*
- *In what ways are you not “putting on Christ” but you know you need to by God’s grace?*
- *Are there areas of discouragement and defeat in your Christian life because you just don’t know how to kill sin and put on Christ? If so, what would God want you to do?*

⑥ **REMEMBER:** Grace is working when you are putting off sin and putting on Christ.

- *How do you see grace at work in your life?*
- *How do you want to see grace at work in your life?*
