- *How does the holiness of God help us understand the chasm between God and mankind (look at Isaiah 6 and the response of Isaiah to God’s holiness)?*

② **Read 1 Corinthians 15:54-55 out loud, discuss the implications of these verses.**

- *If these prophecies truly come true in Jesus, then how should we live?*

③ **How does death serve as the constant reminder of our sinfulness?**

- *How does both the unwritten and written law of God condemn us?*

④ **What is the nature of the victory in 1 Corinthians 15:57?**

- *What is the wrong understanding of the word victory?*
- *In the context of 1 Corinthians 15, what is included in this victory provided by Jesus?*
- *Why is it significant that “gives us the victory” is a present tense verb?*

Practically, what does it look like to be steadfast & immovable?

- ⑤ ● *How does the gospel of Jesus Christ and specifically the resurrection of Jesus provide stability for the Christian?*

- *Have you ever thought about how the resurrection should move you to God-glorifying, Christ-exalting work? What would this look like in your life?*

- *How does Mathew 28:18-20 help us understand the final phrase in 1 Corinthians 15:58 - "knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain"?*
