## INTRODUCTION

#### THE READING PLAN

There are a couple of reasons we chose the 5-Day Bible Reading Plan. First, it's a plan that reads through the entire Bible in one year. Whereas some plans may read the New Testament twice, or may only cover certain parts of the Bible, it was important for us to go through the entire Bible once.

Second, it's five days rather than seven. This allows for two makeup days on the weekend. The reality is, we're human, and we'll miss days in our reading. We thought it was important to have two days during every week to makeup any missed reading.

Third, it is somewhat chronological. You'll notice about the reading that some chapters and books are not in the order listed in the table of contents in your Bible (e.g. Psalm 19 is a reading on day 1). This is so that what you're reading, for the most part, is in the order of when events actually occurred. So Chronicles is going to line up with Kings, Psalms is going to be sprinkled in, aligning thematically to the other readings for the day, and so on. By the end of the year, you will have read every word of the Bible.

#### THE PRAYER GUIDE

This guide uses the A.C.T.S. (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication) prayer model as a guide. This is **not** a secret formula in order for God to hear your prayers. Rather, this is simply helping you build a routine in your prayer life. That being said, here's how to use this guide:

- 1. Read the scripture for the given day. Remember there are only five days in the reading week, so utilize the two makeup days on the weekend if necessary.
- 2. Turn to the Prayer Guide (pg. 3-4) and answer the "Key Questions" under each section. It can be helpful to write your responses on a sheet of paper or in a prayer journal. This can help maintain your focus during prayer.
- 3. Add the Church-Wide Supplications (pg. 5-6) to your requests. If there was a particular person you prayed for, consider sending them a text, give them a call, or send them a note to tell them you prayed for them.

### PRAYER GUIDE

#### **ADORATION**

Prayers of adoration are prayers of worshipful praise to God for who he is – his character, his nature, and his work.

**KEY QUESTION:** What praiseworthy attribute(s) of God was on display in any of the texts that you read today? Praise God for these as you've seen them in your life.

#### CONFESSION

Prayers of confession identify sins you have committed, agree with God that they are sins, admit that you did them, and express your desire to act in accordance with His will in the future.

**KEY QUESTIONS:** Were there any sins on display in the text you read today (Characters disobeying God, the author identifying sinful deeds, etc.)? Are you guilty of sins similar to these? Are you tempted in similar ways? Confess these sins to him, and ask for help to avoid these temptations in the future.

### THANKSGIVING

Prayers of thanksgiving focus on specific ways God has provided for you. While similar to adoration, thanksgiving isn't praising God for who he is (creator, redeemer, healer, Lord, etc.), but for what he has done (healing my friend, saving my child, etc.).

**KEY QUESTIONS:** Did God act in the text that brought to mind a way he has acted on your behalf in the past? Thank him for those things. If not, what has he done in your life for which you should be grateful?

### SUPPLICATION

Prayers of supplication are simply making your requests known to God. In supplication, we are soldiers in the midst of battle, asking our commander for supplies.

**KEY QUESTIONS:** What are you currently worried about? Where do you need God to intervene? Ask God for these things, remembering that He cares for you!

### **CHURCH-WIDE SUPPLICATION**

#### **MONDAY**

Pray for the lost people in your life. Pray that you would be able to have interactions that would lead to sharing the gospel. Pray that God would give you the words to say.

#### TUESDAY

Pray for Emmanuel Baptist Church. Pray for unity of the body. Pray for growth (both of our members growing deeper in knowledge and wisdom, and also for God to bring new believers into our midst). Pray for the leadership to make wise, God-honoring decisions. Pray for specific churches in our area to boldly proclaim the name of Christ (name them if you know them).

#### WFDNFSDAY

Pray specifically for the people inside and outside of our congregation that are sick. Ask specifically that God would heal them.

#### THURSDAY

Pray for all those in your life that are difficult for you to love or those with whom you are at odds. Pray that God would soften your heart to them, and theirs to you. Pray for their well-being.

#### FRIDAY

Pray for our governmental leaders (Federal, State, and Local level), regardless of political affiliation. Pray for wisdom to make God-honoring decisions. Pray for a spiritual awakening to happen in Tuscaloosa and throughout our nation.

#### SATURDAY

Pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who are being persecuted. Pray that God would give them the strength to endure. Pray for the Christ to be made known through their bloodshed. Pray for the missionaries that are at work around the world. Pray that they wouldn't lose heart. Pray that they would be

#### SUNDAY

Pray for the worship service at EBC. Pray that God would be exalted through the preached word. Pray that God would be praised through the corporate singing. Pray that people would come to repentance for indwelling sin. Pray that sinners would come to Christ today. Pray that the hearts of God's people in our church would be revived for His glory.

### **FASTING**

New to the 2019 Bible Reading and Prayer Guide, EBC will be corporately practicing the spiritual discipline of fasting. For some, medical issues may make fasting an impossibility. If that is the case for you, we would not recommend you participate in fasting with us, but please do join us as we pray. For all others, consulting a physician may be necessary before fasting.

Fasting is a practice that has largely fallen out of favor with many in the church today. However, it was practiced weekly in Jesus' day, and in the New Testament, it's assumed that Jesus' disciples would fast (note: "When you fast..." in Matt. 6:16).

Very simply, fasting is abstaining from food for an extended period of time. For the Christian, a fast is observed so as to devote time in prayer. The hunger pains, created because of the absence of food, are a reminder that your soul needs nourishment both from the scriptures, and from communion with God through prayer. For Emmanuel Baptist Church, we will be fasting from food, but we will be feasting on the word of God, and on the nourishment he provides us through prayer. During the fasting days, please

be sure to drink plenty of water. If you cannot participate in a complete fast from food (i.e. for medical reasons), you might choose to abstain from certain things you have regularly (coffee, dessert, breads, etc.).

In preparation for fasting, I would encourage you to listen to the sermon on fasting (if you haven't already) that was preached on September 30, 2018 entitled, "Fasting." (https://www.emmanueltuscaloosa.org/sermons/sermon/2018-09-30/fasting). This will explain the theological significance of fasting, and why it is that we will be practicing this discipline.



Leading up to the day of fasting, EBC members will receive an email discussing the day and what it is that we will be praying for together. Please consider joining us in these days of dedicated prayer as it will prove profitable for your spiritual growth and for the life of our church.
