What is prayer?

Prayer is pouring out our hearts to God in <u>praise</u>, <u>petition</u>, <u>confession of sin</u>, and <u>thanksgiving</u>.

- New City Catechism, Question 38

What is a helpful handle for prayer? A.C.T.S.

- A doration : Praise the Lord for being the awesome God that He is!
- **C** onfession : Admit your sins and ask for God's overflowing forgiveness and mercy in your life.
- **T** hanksgiving: Thank God for all the wonderful things He has done.
- **S** upplication: Bring requests for yourself and for others to God.

What are some attitudes in prayer to consider?

- Prayer is part of worship and worship involves our whole lives, not just certain dedicated times.
- We can listen to God's word before we speak to Him in order to reorientate our hearts to His.
- Jesus Christ teaches that we ought to pray in his name, to the Father, and with the Spirit's help.
- We must remember that God is our good Father as well as that God is God and we are not.
- We should prioritize the spiritual and eternal over the circumstantial and temporal.
