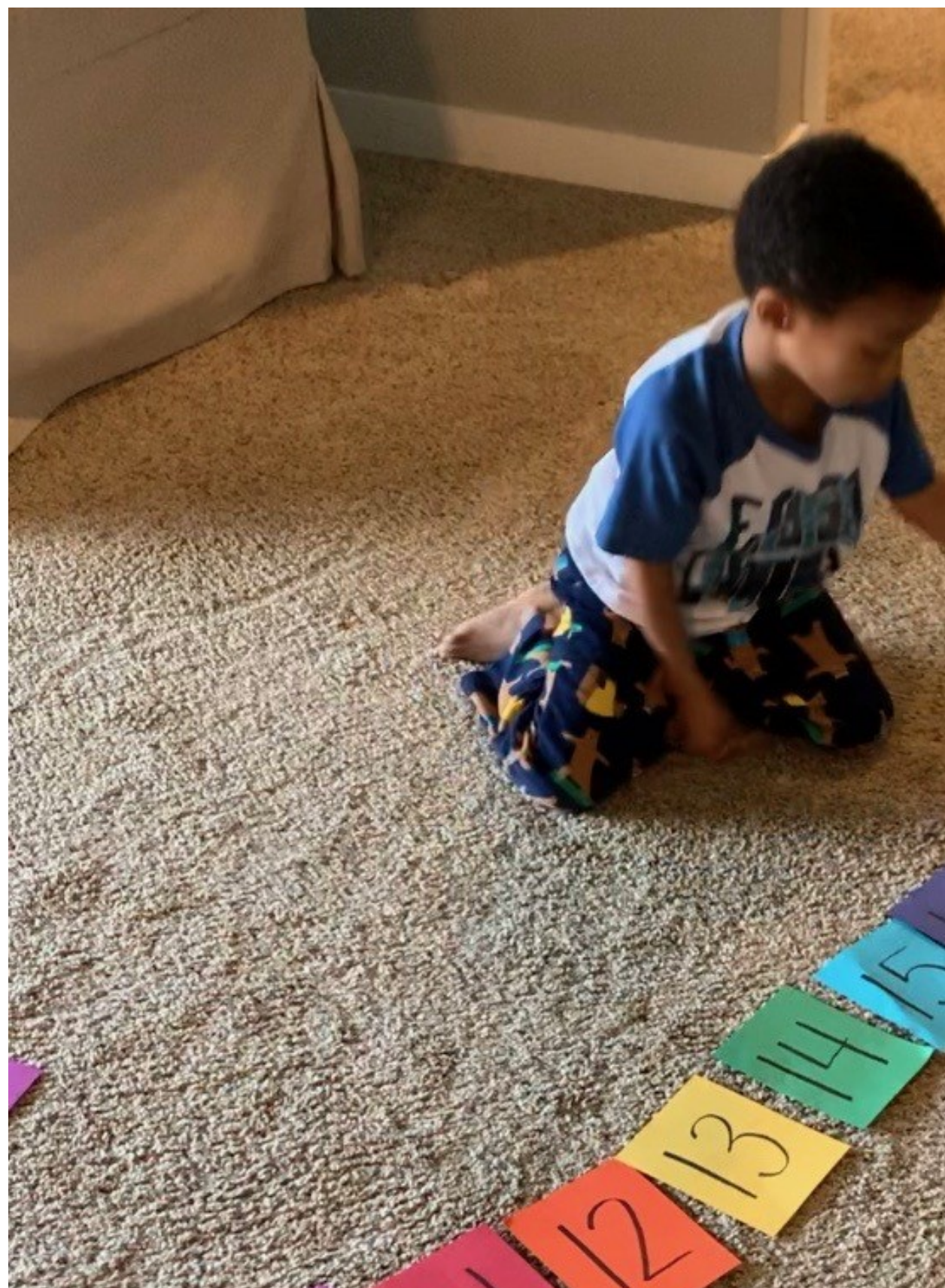


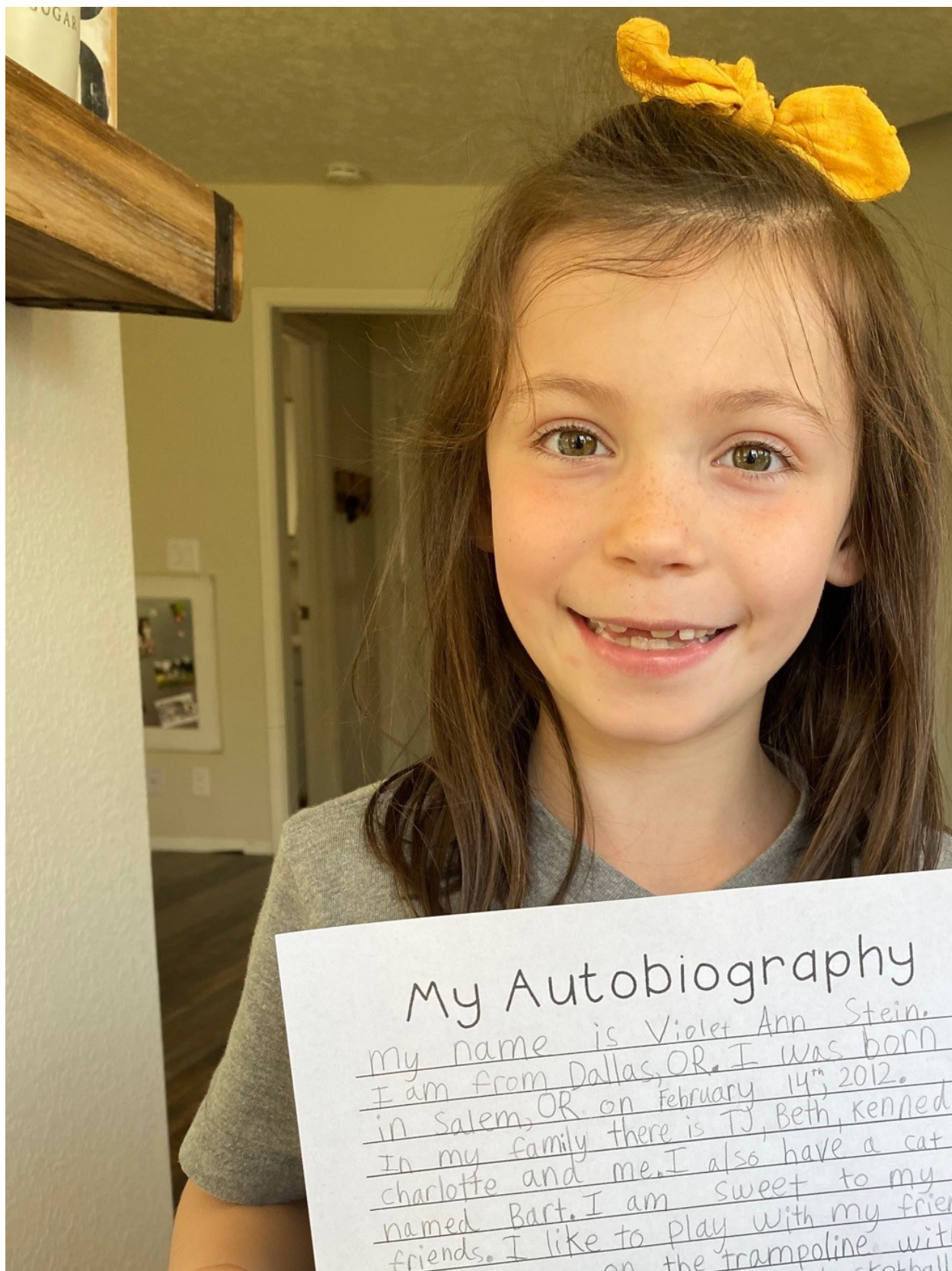












My Autobiography
