<b>1. God Creates Us in His Image</b> (Genesis 1)	God is creative	...so we're creative.	
<b>2. Builders Try to Build a Great Tower</b> (Genesis 11:1-9)	God is the greatest	...and we don't need to be.	"Have you never heard? Have you never understood? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth. He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding" (Isaiah 40:28).  "The Lord is compassionate and merciful, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love" (Psalm 103:8).
<b>3. Abram Gives Lot the Best Land</b> (Genesis 13)	God is giving	...so we're giving.	
<b>4. God Is I Am</b> (Exodus 3:1-4:17)	God doesn't change	...so we trust him when we're unsure.	
<b>5. God Shows Power and Sends Ten Plagues</b> (Exodus 7:14-12:30)	God is all-powerful	...so we respect him.	
<b>6. God Makes Bitter Water Good</b> (Exodus 15:22-27)	God shows grace	...so we show grace.	
<b>7. God Sends Manna and Quail</b> (Exodus 16:1-35)	God is loyal	...so we're loyal.	
<b>8. Moses Sees God's Holiness</b> (Exodus 33-34)	God is special	...and he has the ability to change us.	
<b>9. God Makes the Sun Stand Still</b> (Joshua 10:1-15)	God is our defender	...so we defend others.

<b>10. God Speaks to Samuel</b> (1 Samuel 3)	God speaks	...so we listen for him.	
<b>11. An Idol Bows to God's Ark</b> (1 Samuel 5:1-5)	God is real	...so we believe he's the one true God.	"So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows" (Matthew 10:31).
<b>12. David Values Saul's Life</b> (1 Samuel 24; 26)	God values people	...so we value people.	
<b>13. David Celebrates</b> (2 Samuel 6)	God is praiseworthy	...so we celebrate him.	
<b>BONUS CHRISTMAS LESSON</b> <b>Jesus Is Born in a Stable</b> (Luke 2:1-7)	Jesus is humble	...so we show humility.	"He took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being" (Philippians 2:7).
<b>BONUS EASTER LESSON</b> <b>Jesus Has Victory Over Death</b> (John 19:16-20:18)	God wins	...so we have victory over sin and death.	"But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:57).

Title/Scripture Reference	Point	Application	Summary Verse
<b>1. David Is Kind to Mephibosheth</b> (2 Samuel 9)	God is kind	...so we're kind.	
<b>2. God Provides Food for Elijah</b> (1 Kings 17:1-6)	God is our provider	...so we depend on him.	"He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us" (2 Corinthians 1:4).
<b>3. A Widow Shares Her Last Bread</b> (1 Kings 17:8-16)	God is generous	...so we're generous.	
<b>4. God Comforts Elijah</b> (1 Kings 19)	God is comforting	...so we comfort others.	
<b>5. God Takes Elijah to Heaven</b> (2 Kings 2:1-18)	God is mysterious	...so we have faith.	
<b>6. God Surrounds Elisha With an Army</b> (2 Kings 6:8-23)	God is everywhere	...so we look for him around us.	
<b>7. God Is Faithful to Nehemiah</b> (Nehemiah 1-2)	God is faithful	...so we're faithful.	"For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it?" (Isaiah 43:19).
<b>8. God Is Our Creator</b> (Psalm 139:1-18)	God is our creator	...so we live out our purpose.	
<b>9. God Helps Daniel Eat Wisely</b> (Daniel 1)	God is wise	...so we make wise choices.

<b>10. God Delights in His People</b> (Zephaniah 3:16-17; Luke 15:8-10; Psalm 18:19; Psalm 37:23; Psalm 149:3-5)	God is joyful	...so we're joyful.	"Worship the Lord with gladness. Come before him, singing with joy" (Psalm 100:2).
<b>11. God Hears Zechariah's Prayer</b> (Luke 1:5-25, 57-66)	God hears our prayers	...so we trust his timing.	
<b>12. Jesus Heals an Official's Son</b> (John 4:43-54)	Jesus is amazing	...so we believe in him.	
<b>13. Jesus Teaches Us to Live Differently</b> (Matthew 5-7) (abridged)	Jesus is different	...so we live differently.

Title/Scripture Reference	Point	Application	Summary Verse
<b>1. Jesus Calls Matthew to Be His Friend</b> (Matthew 9:9-13)	Jesus is our friend	...so we're good friends to others.	
<b>2. Jesus Heals a Deformed Hand on the Sabbath</b> (Mark 3:1-6)	Jesus is bold	...so we're bold.	"A friend is always loyal, and a brother is born to help in time of need" (Proverbs 17:17).
<b>3. Jesus Brings a Widow's Son Back to Life</b> (Luke 7:11-17)	Jesus is compassionate	...so we're compassionate.	
<b>4. The Parable of the Lost Treasure and Pearl</b> (Matthew 13:44-46)	God is a treasure	...so we value him more than anything.	
<b>5. Jesus Heals Jairus' Daughter</b> (Luke 8:40-42, 49-56)	Jesus is dependable	...so we're dependable.	"For the word of the Lord holds true, and we can trust everything he does" (Psalm 33:4).
<b>6. God Cares for Birds</b> (Matthew 10:29-31)	God cares about the details	...so we care for others no matter who they are.	
<b>7. Jesus Heals a Deaf Man</b> (Mark 7:31-36)	Jesus is wonderful	...so we expect good things from him.

<b>8. Jesus Heals a Crippled Woman on the Sabbath</b> (Luke 13:10-16)	Jesus is loving	...so we're loving.	
<b>9. Jesus Is the Good Shepherd</b> (John 10:1-16)	Jesus knows us	...so we get to know him.	
<b>10. The Parable of the Great Feast</b> (Luke 14:15-24)	Jesus includes everyone	...so we include others.	"Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves" (Philippians 2:3).
<b>11. Jesus Clears the Temple</b> (Matthew 21:12-17)	Jesus stands up for God	...so we stand up for God.	
<b>12. Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet</b> (John 13:1-17)	Jesus is servant-hearted	...so we serve others.	
<b>13. Jesus Shows Us the Way</b> (John 14:1-14)	Jesus brings hope	...so we're hopeful.

Title/Scripture Reference	Point	Application	Summary Verse
<b>1. Jesus Is the Vine and Branches</b> (John 15:1-17)	Jesus is the vine	...so we grow in his love.	
<b>2. Jesus Commits to God's Will</b> (Matthew 26:36-46)	Jesus does hard things	...so we're willing to do hard things.	"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).
<b>3. Jesus Forgives His Enemies</b> (Luke 23:26-43)	Jesus forgives when it's hard	...so we forgive when it's hard.	
<b>4. Jesus Passes On His Power</b> (Psalm 68:18-20; Acts 1:1-20)	Jesus is powerful	...and he gives us power.	
<b>5. Peter's Vision of Animals</b> (Acts 10:9-33)	God is welcoming	...so we're welcoming.	
<b>6. Peter Escapes Prison</b> (Acts 12:6-17)	God is surprising	...so we watch for his surprises.	"Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your name goes all the glory for your unfaithful love and faithfulness" (Psalm 115:1).
<b>7. People Think Paul Is a God</b> (Acts 13:1-14:28)	God is the only God	...and we're not.	
<b>8. Paul Brings Eutychus Back to Life</b> (Acts 20:7-12)	God is miraculous	...and he works through us.

<b>9. Paul Encourages Others During a Shipwreck</b> (Acts 27)	God is encouraging	...so we encourage others.	
<b>10. God Protects Paul From a Snakebite</b> (Acts 28:1-10)	God is our protector	...so we don't worry about a thing.	
<b>11. God's Armor Gives Us Strength</b> (Ephesians 6:10-18)	God is strong	...and we're strong in him.	"A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power" (Ephesians 6:10).
<b>12. Jesus Is Selfless</b> (Philippians 2:1-11)	Jesus is selfless	...so we're selfless.	
<b>13. Forever in Heaven</b> (Revelation 21)	Jesus is forever	...so we can live forever.
