

## MISSION IS POSSIBLE CODE OF CONDUCT

For a Safe, Fun, and Meaningful Week

Since it is a privilege to attend MIP, I will abide by the following rules:

1. Be in the right place at the right time. Act in an appropriate loving, kind manner. Speak words of encouragement. Consider others as more important than yourself. Show the love of Jesus.
2. Be on the schedule of activities. Arrive at 4pm on Sunday. Be on time for all sessions, and food teams.
3. Be on your best behavior to be respectful and helpful to leaders, other students, and church property. Listen and do not talk when leaders are speaking. Use self-control.
4. Be where you are supposed to be:
  - a. Only go in your dorm and no one else's dorm.
  - b. No waiting outside opposite gender dorms.
  - c. If you live in the Annex building, DO NOT leave the Annex once "lights out" until breakfast.
  - d. Only be where adult supervision is, especially during free time. Stay in the fish bowl.
  - e. Shower outside only on the girls' side or boys' side.
5. "No purpling" - no physical or sexual contact. No handholding, kissing, hugging, or sexual touching in cars, at the church, in sessions, during free time or any time. No sharing blankets in Fellowship Hall.
6. No illegal behavior: NO alcoholic drinks, illegal drugs, weapons, knives, smoking of cigarettes, vaping, or marijuana, overdosing of OTC medicine, or pornography on phone or printed materials.
7. Do not dare people to do risky things. No pranks are to be played on others. No "humor" at the expense of others.
8. Be careful about your words and topics of discussion: no swearing, no talking about sexual topics outside of supervised discussion groups.
9. Choose to include new people. Make new friends. No cliques allowed that leave out others in activities or meals.
10. Do not take or use other people's belongings without asking. Do not assume they will think it is all right.
11. Fill out your testimony and evaluation sheet on Thursday night in the Fellowship Hall. Do your share of cleaning your area and dorm! Do not leave your dorm until released by your counselor on Friday morning.
12. Use the buddy system.
13. Do not allow phones to be a distraction for the week! No phones allowed during any Teaching Sessions, Morning Devotions, Evening Praise and Worship, Movies, and Messages.
14. Work on your food team, and work team with a positive attitude and a helpful work ethic.
15. Go to sleep at night! Get up on time!

### CONSEQUENCES

If you do not abide by these rules, you may incur the following:

1. Loss of free time privileges at MIP.
2. Extra chores during free time.
3. Have a counselor assigned to stay with you at all times.
4. Leave MIP. A parent will be called to come pick you up and take you home.
5. Not allowed to come back to next Summer event, retreat, camp, MIP, Youth Group, or Sunday School, without parent.
6. Go through Power Training Course. Six weeks of lessons, six videos to watch, six papers to write, six discussions with parents and Pastor Ann. Complete 25 hours of community service to the church, usually done over summer break.
