SPRING RETREAT CODE OF CONDUCT

For a safe fun Weekend

As a participant in the retreat, I will abide by the following rules:

- 1. Abide by the Health and Safety protocols.
- 2. Be in the right place at the right time. Act in an appropriate loving, kind manner. Speak words of encouragement. Consider others as more important than yourself. Show the love of Jesus.
- 3. Follow the schedule of activities. Be on time for all sessions, group picture, and cabin devotions.
- 4. Be on your best behavior to be respectful and helpful to leaders, other students, and camp property. Listen and do not talk when leaders are speaking. Use self-control.
- 5. Be where you are supposed to be.
 - a. Only go in your cabin and no one else's cabin. Cabin curtains are to stay closed for privacy.
 - b. No waiting outside opposite gender cabins.
 - c. Only be where adult supervision is, especially during free time.
- 6. "No purpling" no physical or sexual contact. No handholding, kissing, hugging, or sexual touching in cars, at camp, in sessions, during free time or any time.
- 7. No illegal behavior: NO alcoholic drinks, illegal drugs, vaping, smoking of cigarettes or marijuana, overdosing of OTC medicine, or pornography on phone or printed materials.
- 8. Do not dare people to do risky things. No pranks are to be played on others. No "humor" at the expense of others.
- 9. Be careful about your words and topics of discussion: no swearing, no talking about sexual topics outside of supervised discussion groups. No mean or cruel talk about others!
- 10. Choose to include new people. Make new friends. No cliques allowed that leave out others in activities or meals.
- 11. Don't take or use other people's belongings without asking. Do not assume they will think it is all right.
- 12. Complete the Testimony and Evaluation sheet on Saturday night in your cabin.
- 13. Do your share of cleaning your cabin! Do not leave your cabin until released by your counselor on Sunday morning. Then go to the Chapel for the final service on Sunday morning.
- 14. Do not allow phones to be a distraction for the weekend! No games on phones during sessions. Turn in phone to the safety box during afternoon activities. Call parents only if needed.
- 15. Use the buddy system. Go with a same gender friend to recreational activities.
- 16. Have no contact with people at SYLC that are not in our group.
- 17. Go to sleep at night. Get up on time. Wear your nametag. Bring your Bible to sessions.

CONSEQUENCES - If you do not abide by these rules, you may incur the following:

- 1. Loss of free time privileges at retreat.
- 2. Extra chores at retreat.
- 3. Have a counselor assigned to stay with you at all times on retreat.
- 4. Leave camp. Parent will be called to come pick you up and take you home.
- 5. Not allowed to come back to next retreat/camp, Youth Group and/or Sunday School w/out a parent.
- 6. Go through Power Training Course. Six weeks of lessons, six videos to watch, six papers to write, six discussions with parents and Pastor Ann. Complete 25 hours of community service to the church, usually done over spring break.
