Paul to leave.



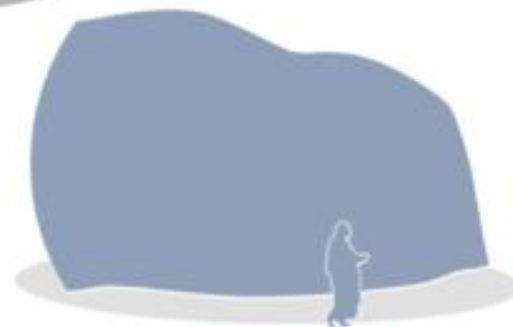

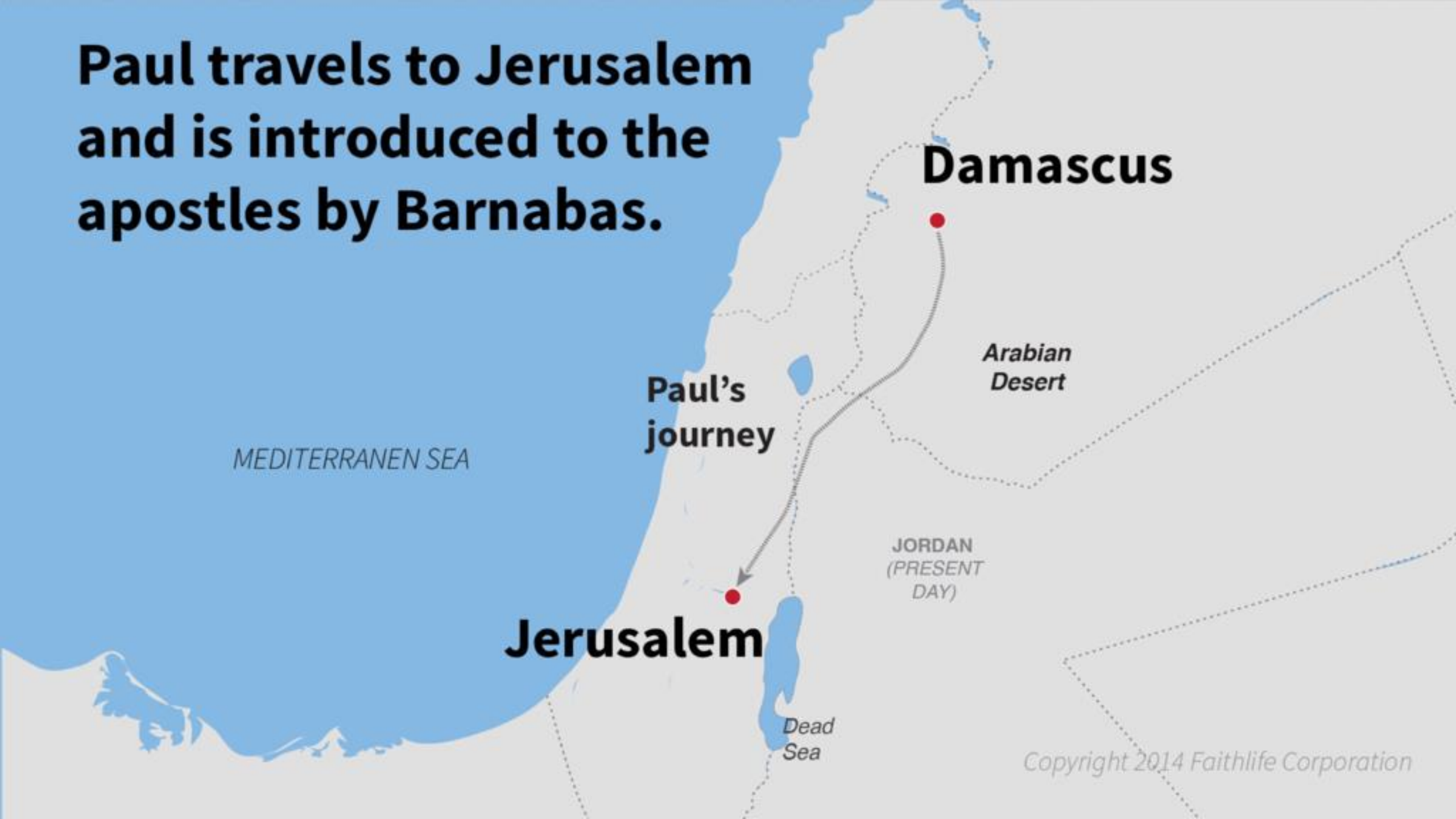

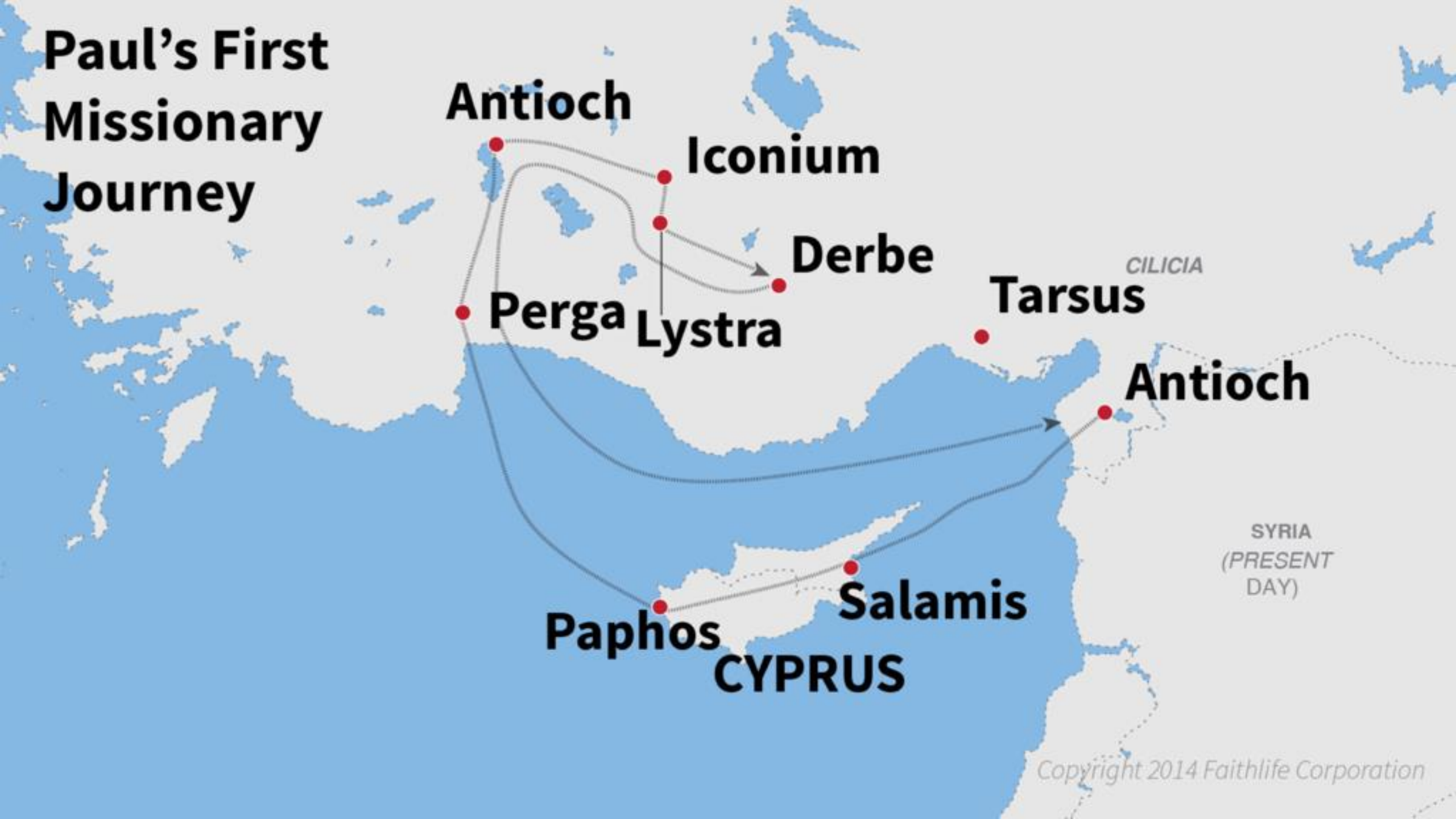
