




Worthy is the Lamb **Revelation 5:1-14**

2. What is the paradoxical picture we find in vv. 5-7? How do we understand the relationship between these two images of Jesus? How does Jesus' death and resurrection bring us comfort according to these verses?
3. Why is Jesus praised in vv. 8-10? What is the connection to the Old Testament in these verses and why is it significant? What is being said about Jesus in vv. 11-14? What is the important doctrine we learn from these verses? How are you encouraged from these verses?
