


Philadelphia: The Church That Was Weak **Revelation 3:7-13**

Main Idea: The church of Philadelphia was weak, but they were loved by Jesus; and because they had kept his word, they would be kept from the hour of trial, and dwell securely with God, if they held fast until the end.

I. Comfort and encouragement for the weak (vv. 7-9)

II. Vindication and protection for the weak (vv. 10-13)
