### ***Athanasian Creed (3-11)***

*Whoever desires to be saved should above all hold to the catholic faith.  
Anyone who does not keep it whole and unbroken will doubtless perish  
eternally.*

*Now this is the catholic faith:  
That we worship one God in trinity and the trinity in unity,  
neither confounding their persons  
nor dividing the essence.*

*For the person of the Father is a distinct person,  
the person of the Son is another,  
and that of the Holy Spirit still another.*

*But the divinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one,  
their glory equal, their majesty coeternal.  
Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit.*

*The Father is uncreated,  
the Son is uncreated,  
the Holy Spirit is uncreated.*

*The Father is immeasurable,  
the Son is immeasurable,  
the Holy Spirit is immeasurable.*

*The Father is eternal,  
the Son is eternal,


