Begin this morning by reading aloud from Psalm 118.

**Everyone: Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good;  
for his steadfast love endures forever!  
Let Israel say, "His steadfast love endures forever."**

Leader: The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.  
This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.

Leader: Save us, we pray, O Lord! O Lord, we pray, give us success!
