#### LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE BIBLE STORY, WORSHIP, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

#### WORSHIP

**WHAT YOU NEED:** "Memory Verse Card" from Week One in Bible; instruments or music player; and this month's worship song, "Silent Night," included in your monthly files; Optional Dance Moves Video for "Silent Night," available in the Media Package if you subscribe or from OrangeKidsMusic.com

**LEADER:** "Friends, I'm SO excited to see you today! My name is [your name]. I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas. Christmas is when we celebrate Jesus' birthday. God gave us Jesus because God loves us! **How do we know God loves us?"** 

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God gave us Jesus."

LEADER: "You've got it! Now stand up on your feet, and let's sing all about it!

Lead children in singing "Silent Night," this month's worship song.

"God loves me. God loves you, too! And He showed us just how much He loves us when He gave us Jesus! The Bible teaches us that 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world (cross arms over chest) so much (pull hands away from each other) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) Let's say our memory verse together with the motions.

Lead children to say the memory verse with the motions.

"Yes, God loves you and God loves me. And we celebrate Jesus' birthday on Christmas. One more time, how do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God gave us Jesus."

**LEADER:** "God loves us SO much God gave us Jesus! That's why Christmas is such a big celebration! Thanks for worshipping with me today. **[Transition]** And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

# **STORY**

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible; Optional Story Images and cardstock

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible.

Open Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"Christmas is when we celebrate that Jesus was born. God loves us so much, God gave us Jesus!

(Option: Display Story Image W5 01)

"Now there were people called wise men who lived very far away. They were waiting for Jesus to be born because they knew Jesus was God's Son.

(Option: Display Story Image W5 02)

"After Jesus was born, God put a special star in the sky to show the wise men the way to Jesus so that they could celebrate Him.

(Option: Display Story Image W5 03)

"The wise men knew they could follow the star to get to Jesus. It was a long journey, but they finally got there! The wise men were SO happy to see Jesus.

(Option: Display Story Image W5 04)

"As soon as they saw Him, they gave Jesus gifts and worshipped Him.

(Option: Display Story Image W5 05)

"They wanted to show how special Jesus is. And we know Jesus is special because Jesus is God's Son! God loves us so much that God gave us Jesus!

"Wow! What an amazing story! Do you think we could start at the beginning and look at the whole Christmas story train? I think we can!

"The true story of Christmas begins with Mary. God sent an angel (point to angel) to tell Mary she would have a baby and the baby would be named . . .?"

Pause for children to respond.

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "JESUS!"

**LEADER:** "And we know Jesus is special because Jesus is God's Son!

"Later, Mary and Joseph (point to Mary and Joseph) went to a town called Bethlehem. Mary and Joseph stayed in a stable where animals live because there were no rooms anywhere else. And that's where Baby Jesus was born—a stable!

"There were some shepherds out in a field taking care of their . . . ?"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "SHEEP!"

**LEADER:** "God sent an angel to tell the shepherds that Jesus had been born. The shepherds ran as fast as they could to find Baby Jesus! When the shepherds got to the stable, they saw Mary, Joseph, and Baby Jesus, just like the angels said they would.

"Later, God sent a star to show some wise men where to find Jesus. When the wise men found Jesus, they worshipped Him and gave Him gifts.

"And that is the true story of Christmas. Christmas is when we celebrate that **God gave us Jesus!** And now that you know the true story of Christmas, when someone asks, **'How do we know God loves us?'**, you can say, **'God gave us Jesus!' How do we know God loves us?"** 

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God gave us Jesus!"

LEADER: "One more time! How do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God gave us Jesus!"

**LEADER:** "Christmas is over, but knowing God loves us and gave us Jesus is something we can celebrate every day! **[Transition]** Our story time is over (*pick up and close Bible*), but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

# PRAYER

**LEADER:** "Dear God, thank You for the true story of Christmas. Help us celebrate Jesus like the wise men did. We don't have to wait for Christmas to celebrate that You love us and gave us Jesus. We can do that every day! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, we pray, amen.

Transition] "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!"

Lead small group to first activity.

# **GETTING READY**

#### HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET READY FOR THIS WEEK

Gather children for a Large Group time that includes interactive worship and the Bible story. The Rug Script is written for those who pull their children to a rug (or area) to one side of their preschool space to tell the Bible story. If you gather your preschoolers together from multiple rooms and have a larger space on which to present the Bible story, you may benefit from using the Stage Script.

# WORSHIP: INVITING PEOPLE TO RESPOND TO GOD (10 MINUTES)

A leader and live instruments are recommended to sing along with the music tracks. Encourage children to be active during worship by incorporating the appropriate hand motions.

# STORY: COMMUNICATING GOD'S TRUTH IN ENGAGING WAYS (10 MINUTES)

Choose an engaging adult to tell the Bible story. This person should be able to command the attention of preschoolers and control the group through animated storytelling. These scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advanced preparation is necessary.
