1. FILL THE TUNNEL

WHAT YOU NEED: Tunnel, painter's tape, plastic container, and ball pit balls

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Tape the tunnel to the wall, making sure the bottom of the tunnel is completely touching

the floor. Put the ball pit balls in the container, and place the container near the tunnel.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to toss the ball pit balls into the tunnel to fill it up. Lift the tunnel to allow all the balls to spill out and fill again.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the farmer filling his barn in today's Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come join me over here at the tunnel."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Pick up a ball and toss it into the tunnel. (*Pause.*) Let's see if we can fill the tunnel with these balls. There are so many balls—will they all fit? (*Pause.*) Wow! Look, we got all the balls into the tunnel. (*Lift the tunnel and allow all the balls to spill out.*) Let's do it again! (*Repeat as many times as desired.*) Friends, you did a great job filling up the tunnel."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Today in our story we'll hear about a farmer who filled up his barns with lots and lots of food. I can't wait to hear more about our story."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by encouraging the children to pretend to pick up food as you walk to the designated area.

2. BIG BARN, LITTLE BARN

WHAT YOU NEED: "Big Barn, Little Barn" Activity Page, cardstock, craft sticks, and mini craft sticks

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Big Barn, Little Barn" on cardstock, three sets per Small Group. Place Activity Pages on table as well as both types of craft sticks.

Encourage children to sit with you at the table.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Lead children in outlining the two different sized barns with the appropriately sized craft sticks. Continue to compare "big" and "little." Slide the craft sticks off and continue as long as there is interest.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Clean up the area by having the children sort the craft sticks into two piles while reviewing "big" and "little" and introducing the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come and sit with me at this table. What do you see? (*Pause.*) Yes, there are two different barns on our Activity Pages. How are they different? (*Pause.*) That's right! One is big, and one is little. Show me with your arms what big looks like. (*Spread your arms out wide.*) Fantastic. Now, show me with your arms what little looks like." (*Put your hands very close together.*)

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Can you point to the big barn for me? (Pause.) Awesome. Now, point to the small barn. (Pause.) Great job! Now, I see some different sized craft sticks here on the table. Let's use the craft sticks on the table to build the barns. Which craft sticks should we use for the little barn? These big craft sticks? (Hold up craft sticks.) Or these little craft sticks? (Hold up mini craft sticks.) I think you're right. Let's use the little craft sticks for the little barn. Help me outline it. (Demonstrate.) Now, let's outline the big barn. Which craft sticks should we use? (Pause.) I agree, let's use the big craft sticks. (Demonstrate.) Excellent! Let's slide the craft sticks off and do it again!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "You did an awesome job outlining the two barns today. Can you help me sort the craft sticks into piles of big and small? (Demonstrate.) In our story today, we're going to hear about a man who had some big barns. I can't wait to hear what he put in them."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by having the children do big and little with their arms.

3. BIBLE TEACHES

WHAT YOU NEED: Different types of preschool learning books—alphabet, numbers, community helper books, etc., and a Bible

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Place the books around you on the floor.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to choose a book and explore the pages inside. Ask children to tell you some of the pictures they recognize on the covers or inside the books as they look through them. Encourage the children to switch books with other friends when they are done with their book. Continue until all children have explored at least one book.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce that the Bible is where Jesus teaches us important things.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, how many of you love to read books? (*Pause.*) How many of you like to have someone read you a book? (*Pause.*) Now, who likes to learn things from books? Like the alphabet or numbers, or how to tie your shoes? (*Pause.*) Books are so fun and can teach us so many things!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "We have lots of books to explore today. I would like everyone to find a book and look at all the pictures. Tell me some of the things and people you see in your book. (*Pause.*) When you are done looking through your book, switch books with a friend and explore their book! (*Pause.*) Great job exploring all of these fun books, friends! I bet you all learned so many things."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Books can teach us a lot of things. (Hold up Bible.) Who knows what this book is called? (Pause.) The Bible, that's right! The Bible is a very special and important book. It's where Jesus teaches us important things. Today, in our Bible Story, we're going to learn about how Jesus teaches us to share."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by naming things we can share (toys, books, playground swings, food, love, JESUS, etc.) and all the people we can share them with (siblings, cousins, friends, classmates, neighbors, parents, grandparents, etc.).

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Gather the children in your activity area. Review the Memory verse with the motions.

BIBLE STORY

Jesus teaches us that we can share.

BIGGER BARNS ACTS 2:45; LUKE 12:16-23 **DURING THE ACTIVITY:** Then lead the children to sing the words of the verse to the tune of "The Farmer in the Dell."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Remind the children that the people were amazed by Jesus' teaching because it IS amazing!

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Now let's sing the verse. I'll sing it once and then you can join me."

2. ALL TANGLED UP

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "All Tangled Up" Activity Page, copy paper, and washable markers or crayons

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "All Tangled Up" on copy paper, one per child.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Give each child an "All Tangled Up" Activity Page. Show the children how to trace the lines with their finger to see which line goes to Jesus and which lines go to the barns. Next, tell the children to trace the line that goes to Jesus with a marker or crayon.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how Jesus teaches us important things—like how we can share with others.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Come sit with me at the table. Look at your paper—it has lines that are all tangled up."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Look at your paper. There is a picture of two barns and a picture of Jesus at the top. Use your finger to trace the lines to find which line goes to Jesus and which lines go to the barns. When you find the line that goes to Jesus, use a marker or crayon to trace that line. (*Pause.*) Great job!

"Jesus told a story about a farmer. This farmer grew a lot of good food, and he wanted to put all the food into his barns. The barns filled up, but there was still more food. The farmer could have shared his food but he didn't! He decided he would build BIGGER barns! The farmer could fill them up and keep ALL the food for himself. It would be WAY more food than he needed, but he wanted to keep it all

What did Jesus teach us we can do instead of keeping everything for ourselves? (*Pause*.) Yes, Jesus teaches us it is important to share what we have. Sharing with others is important."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "I'm so glad Jesus teaches us important things, like sharing! Who teaches you important things? Jesus teaches me important things!"

3. WHAT WILL YOU SHARE? [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Butcher or chart paper and a marker

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Set the chart paper and marker near the table. Gather the children around the table.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Leader draws an object on the page of items they can share. Encourage the children to guess the item and talk about how they can share that item with a friend. Repeat as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come find a spot at the table."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "I'm going to draw something on the paper, and I want you to tell me what it is and how you can share it. Ready? (Draw a simple swing.) What do you see? (Pause.) A swing! How can you share a swing? (Pause.) Yes, you can give a friend a turn on the swing. Good job! (Draw a snack/ cookie.) What do you see? (Pause.) A cookie. How could you share this? (Pause.) Yes, you can split the cookie in half and share with a friend. (Draw a toy block.) What do you see? (Pause.) A block. Can you share your blocks? Yes! (Draw a ball.) What do you see? (Pause.) A ball. Can you share your ball? (Pause.) You sure can! Great job, friends!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Jesus teaches us so many important things! One of the important things Jesus teaches is that we can share. We can share our toys and our snacks! I'm so glad Jesus teaches us important things. Tell me: Who teaches you important things? Jesus teaches me important things."

5. SHARING BARN* [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Allergy Alert Poster," "Sharing Barn" and "Sharing Barn Parent Note" Activity Pages, cardstock, paper lunch bags, crayons, glue sticks, small snack bags of popcorn or cereal, scissors, and a permanent marker

*Be sure to list the items you will be using today on the "Allergy Alert Poster" (in the Prelude folder) and post it at the door to your room.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock and list the bagged snack options you are offering, and post at the door. Copy "Sharing Barn" on cardstock and cut, one per child. Copy "Sharing Barn Parent Note" on cardstock and cut, one per child. Write each child's name on their bag.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to color their barn and then glue it to one side of their bag. If time allows, encourage children to decorate the rest of their bag. Leader adds the Parent Note and two small bags of snacks inside of each bag. Fold the top down and set aside to send home, talk about finding a someone to share the snack inside with. Review the Bible Story.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit with me. We're going to make a barn to help us remember why Jesus taught us the bigger barns story."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Our story was about a farmer who grew a lot of good food. He put all the food into his barns to keep for himself. Use the crayons to decorate your barn picture. (Pause.) The farmer had more food than would fit in his barns. What did the farmer do with the extra food? Did he share it? (Pause.) No! He built bigger barns! Glue your barn to the paper bag. (Pause.) The farmer had way more food than he needed, but he wanted to keep it all to himself. The farmer could have shared his food and helped a lot of people. Jesus told this story to teach us that it is important to share what we have. I am going to put two snacks in your barn for you to take home. Your job is to do what Jesus taught us today and find someone to share your snack with."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "There are a lot of ways we can share. We can share a toy, or a snack—we can even share a turn on the swing! Jesus teaches us that God wants us to share. I'm so glad Jesus teaches us important things. Who teaches you important things? Jesus teaches me important things."

6. JOURNAL AND PRAYER [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Verse Card" Activity Page from Week One in Bible, a journal, and a fun-shaped pen

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: If you do not have the "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible, copy "Memory Verse Card" on

cardstock and cut, one per Small Group. Place one card in your Bible at Matthew 7:28. Keep this card in your Bible all month.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to pretend to drive a tractor as you lead them to your Small Group spot. Sit down and gather the children around you. Review the Memory verse and motions, then encourage children to help you make a list of things we can share.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Pray with the children using the list you made in the journal.

WHAT YOU SAY:

about a farmer who grew a lot of food, let's pretend we are driving a farm tractor to our Small Group spot. Crank your tractors, little farmers, and follow me! (Pretend you are driving a tractor as you lead the children to your Small Group spot.) Whoa! Let's stop here so we can talk about today's Bible Story. One, two, three, sit down with me!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: (Open the Bible and lay it in front of the children.) "In our Bible Story today, Jesus told a story about a man who grew A LOT of food. It was way more food than what the man needed. Did the man share some of his food, or did the man build bigger barns to store all of the food for himself? (Pause.) You're right. The man built bigger barns, and he kept all of the food for himself. What could the man have done with some of the food instead of keeping it all for himself? (Pause.) Yes! The man could have shared his food with people who needed it! Jesus told this story to teach us something important. We can share! I'm so glad Jesus teaches us important things! - Painter's tape

- Bible

Create a safe place to connect through activities written to reach every learning style while reinforcing the Bottom Line introduced during the Bible Story and applying it to real-life experiences.
