




Around the World

STEPS TO MEMBERSHIP


After reviewing the 4 steps to membership below, please visit the Next Steps area at the end of a Sunday morning worship service. Someone will be available to talk with you about church membership and any other questions you might have about First Baptist or your relationship with God.

- Commit your life to Jesus Christ and trust Him alone for your salvation. This involves repenting of your sin, placing your faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ and surrendering control of your life to Jesus Christ as Lord.
- Present yourself as a candidate for membership in the Next Steps area after a Sunday morning worship service.
- Baptism by immersion (under water) after you have committed yourlife to Christ. All members of First Baptist Church are baptized after they are saved; however, baptism in our church is not necessary if you have received immersion baptism at another evangelical church.
- Complete the "Welcome to the Family" class. (Adults only)

BAPTISM

Christian baptism is the immersion of a believer in water in the name, of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is an act of obedience symbolizing the believer's faith in a crucified, buried, and risen Savior, the believer's death to sin, the burial of the old life, and the resurrection to walk in newness of life in Christ Jesus. It is a testimony to one's faith.

All members of Fort Mill First Baptist are baptized after they are saved; however, baptism in our church is not necessary if you have received immersion baptism at another evangelical church. Visit the Next Steps area after a morning worship service in the Worship Center. A connect team member can answer any of your questions and record the needed information for the church to schedule your baptism.

We use a secure check-in system to ensure children are checked in and out by the same individuals, and a security team monitors all individuals entering the Fort Mill Kids areas.
