HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF FIRST BAPTIST

(Public decisions can be made during the invitation time of any service.)

◆ **By Profession of Faith**

If you have never received Jesus as Savior and Lord and/or never publicly confessed Him, you will be given an opportunity to do so. After your decision has been confirmed, your baptism will be scheduled.

◆ **By Transfer**

Any person from another Baptist Church of like faith and order may be received into membership by transfer of letter from the respective church.

◆ **By Statement of Faith**

If you know in your heart that you have previously experienced salvation by receiving Jesus as Savior and Lord, we will be happy to receive you. However, it will be necessary for you to be baptized at First Baptist if you have never been baptized by immersion after your salvation experience or if you were baptized in a church which holds a different view of salvation, baptism, or eternal security than First Baptist.

- d.) When there is at least one person who has wronged you that you refuse to forgive.
- e.) When the words of your mouth are displeasing to God and dishonorable to others.
- f.) When you are not seeing answered prayer or God's power in your life.
- g.) When you have time for entertainment, but not for Bible study and prayer.
- h.) When you let pride, worry, or fear stop you from obeying what God has told you to do.
- i.) When your family sees you behave one way at church and another way at home.
- k.) When you enjoy viewing things you know are unholy and displeasing to God.
- l.) When you know people who have things against you, but you make no effort to reconcile with them.
- m.) When your worship is casual and singing is halfhearted.
- n.) When your giving is reluctant and calculated, rather than extravagant and sacrificial.
- o.) When you have to be begged to serve in the church.
- p.) When you are unresponsive to the neighbors, associates, and friends around you who will likely die without Christ, and you make little effort to share your faith with them.
- q.) When you are blind to your spiritual condition and don't really think you need to repent or change anything.
