


NOMINATING COMMITTEE REQUEST:

This is precisely the way the church should function; not just at a potluck meal, but day in and day out. Our attitude should be that of Jesus. Christians should "look not only to our own interests but also to the interests of others" (Philippians 2:4). We should desire "not to be served, but to serve" (Mark 10:45). We should generously offer as much as we can possibly afford to share. When the whole church lives this way, we experience the same phenomenon the early church experienced, "There was not a needy person among them" (Acts 4:34). The abundance of the wealthy supplies the needs of the poor, "that there might be fairness" (2 Corinthians 8:14) and no one goes away hungry.
