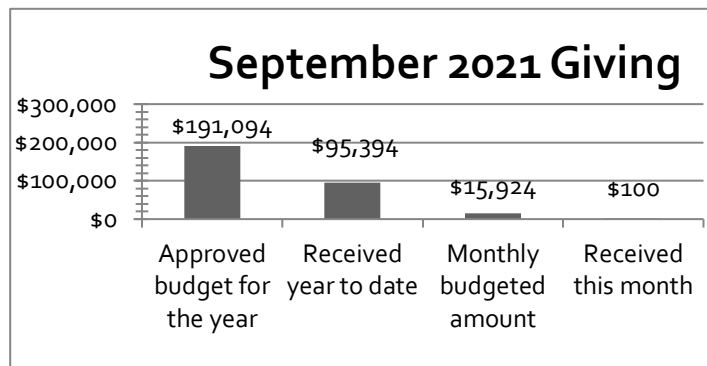


Birthday's: Denise Weimer 09/16
