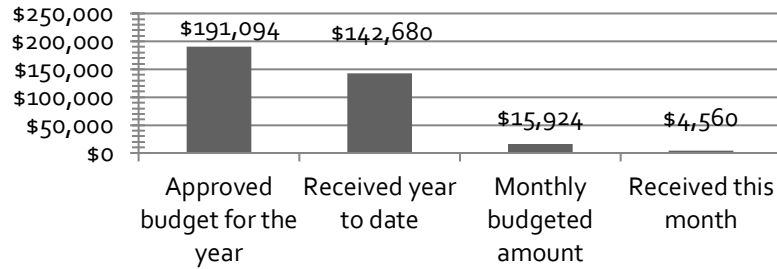


## December 2021 Giving

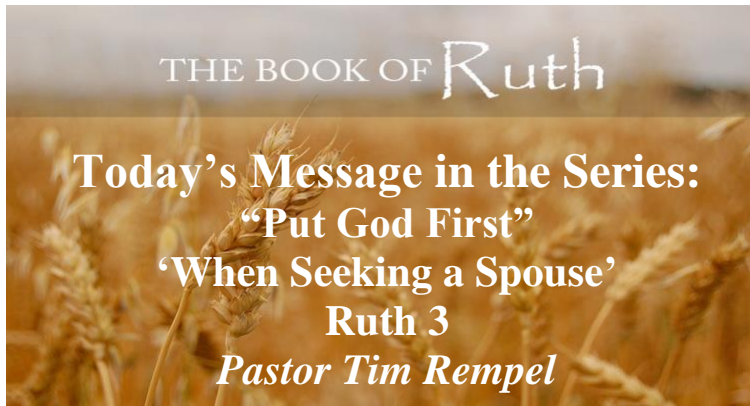
