## **ADVENT & CHRISTMAS**

"But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ The Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger." (Luke 2:10-12)

This is the most wonderful news that human ears have ever heard! God knew that we were lost in our sins. God loved us so much that He sent us a Savior. Jesus came in such a humble way. He was born in a cattle stall. His mother wrapped Him in cloths and laid him in a manger. This was exactly what we needed. A Savior who became one of us. "Immanuel" means God with us. This is who Jesus is. This is the wonderful news that we celebrate every Advent and Christmas.

This year my Sunday morning messages during Advent will focus on "The Characters of Christmas." On November 27<sup>th</sup> we looked at the Prophets. On December 4<sup>th</sup> we will reflect on the lives of **Joseph & Mary**. On December 11<sup>th</sup> we will consider the Shepherds and the Angels. On December 18<sup>th</sup> we will ponder the arrival of the Magi. Finally, on Christmas morning, December 25<sup>th</sup> we will hear those often-repeated words "*Do not be afraid*." On Sunday evenings in December, I will continue working through the Gospel of Mark. We will focus on chapters 11 and 12 which record the beginning of the last week of Jesus. There will not be an evening service on December 25<sup>th</sup>. On January 1<sup>st</sup> we will bring our study of the Gospel of Mark back into the morning services.

I want to thank you for your generous giving to the Lord. We collected 33 Shoe boxes from our congregation. We are also collecting your gifts for the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering during the month of December. This is all over and above our regular giving to the ministry of our church. This is a lot of giving and we appreciate your generosity.
