May is a marvelous month for Mission trips and Mother's Day!

As many of you already know I am being sent by you, my Church Family, to Ukraine from May 5th until May 16th. My fellow pastor Greg Perkins, from Waterford, and I will be staying at a Bible College dorm in Kherson. We will be meeting with Pastors and others who are in training for ministry. We want to learn how our Association of Baptist Churches can partner with them in ministry. I would appreciate your prayer support as I go. I am looking forward to sharing a report with you when I get back.

On May 2nd, just before I leave for Ukraine, we will be celebrating the Lord's Supper together in our 11am Worship service. I will be preaching from Proverbs 8 on "Wisdom's Call." Please join us for this service and for Powerhouse on that Sunday evening.

May 9th is **Mother's Day**. Our Associate Pastor, Tim Weimer, will be preaching and there will be a special recognition of all the Mothers in attendance. We will not have any evening activities on **Mother's Day**. We want you to spend time with your Moms.

Pastor Tim Weimer will also be preaching on May 16th, in the morning service. Powerhouse will resume on that Sunday evening. Mike Dalton will teach the adult scripture lesson.

When I return from my trip to Ukraine, I will begin teaching an **Adult VBS** class on Wednesday evenings, beginning May 19th at 7pm. This will be for the adults who are serving in **Vacation Bible School** this summer, or anyone else who is interested in what they would hear if they were attending the Adult **VBS** sessions in July.

Our Association will have a **Mid-Annual meeting** on Friday May 21st. It will begin with a supper at 5pm and continue with some Mission reports. Our church is invited to attend and we may send up to three messengers.

On May 22nd I will conclude a series of messages called "**Life: Parental Guidance Advised!**" from Proverbs 1-9. We will be presented with a choice between "Lady Wisdom and Madam Folly." (Proverbs 9).
