

Instructions for Gyve

How to set up your account:

Gyve is primarily an app-based platform so setting it up through an app on your phone or tablet is the recommended method, but if you prefer to set it up through your computer, the website is listed below.

Setting up your account with the app on your phone/tablet:

1. Download the Gyve app from your app store or text the word **gyve** to 313131 and follow the prompts.
2. Supply the prompted information to set up your account.
3. You will be asked if you want to enable Round Up or you can skip for now. More information on Roundup below.

Setting up your account online from your computer:

1. Go to <https://gyve.io/give/fcs> and select one time or recurring gift.
2. On the next screen, go to the bottom and select **Don't have an account/ register**.
3. Supply the prompted information to set up your account.
4. You will be asked if you want to enable Round Up or you can skip for now. More information on Roundup below.

To use Gyve during this transitional period, you will need to use the app or the web address above. By the end of August, you will also be able to use Gyve through OneLife and our website (fcclife.me).

Setting up recurring giving with Gyve:

If you currently give via a recurring gift through our website or OneLife, it is actually processed through Pushpay. You will now need to set up your recurring giving via these steps in Gyve:

1. Open the Gyve app or website and choose “Recurring” on the dashboard, then choose “Give”.
2. You will be redirected to a page where you can set up your preferred recurring gift amount and frequency.
3. When you make this change you will also have the opportunity to sign up for “Round Up”. (See below)
4. Once you have signed up for recurring giving with Gyve, we will cancel your Pushpay recurring gift. You will receive an email confirmation from Pushpay of this cancellation.

Round Up

With Round Up, you can give your spare change from everyday purchases to impact our community. Our vision for Round Up is that as our spare change accumulates the church will identify and research a need in the community. We will then use these funds to bless an individual, family or group in our community.

When you choose to participate in Round Up, you will be asked to identify an account or debit/credit card from which you make regular purchases. These purchases will be rounded up to the nearest dollar. Once your spare change has accumulated to \$20 it will be sent from your account to the church to be used as a blessing as described above.

(In keeping with our teaching, if you choose to use a credit card, we recommend it is used as a convenience, paying it off every month rather than accumulating debt.)

Any account information used in signing up is not kept by Gyve, rather it is securely transferred to your banking institution for the necessary permission to set up the account.
