What a cool morning we had together on Sunday, February 16! I loved seeing so many of you respond to the call to extend God's grace by putting your thumbprint on the painting we are going to display for all to see in the church foyer. The thought of a couple hundred or so grace-filled ambassadors of Jesus roaming around our portion of Northern Indiana fills my heart with excitement. I have been praying for you every day and will continue to do so.

As a little encouragement in your own personal outreach, here is something I'll be sharing in our new BLESS series:

In Luke 15:4-7, Jesus tells the Parable of the Lost Sheep.

"Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninetynine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there is more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

We like it when Jesus comes looking for us. But did you catch where "the found" are when He goes looking for others? He leaves them in the open country. Huh?

I appreciate what my friend Dr. Rick Richardson at Wheaton College says about this in his book, *Evangelism* Outside the Box:

"I have always struggled with the parable of the lost sheep. Jesus leaves the ninety-nine to go find the one lost sheep. I see myself as one of the ninety-nine. Doesn't Jesus care about me? Then one day I realized there was a way to address my dilemma. I could follow Jesus. If I went out looking for the lost sheep, he would never leave me or forsake me!"

What if we went looking too? What if we got on mission WITH Jesus?

That is exactly what we are doing at First Christian Church. We are people on mission with Jesus – full time. Remember to start each day with an outward focused morning prayer, and go out to be a blessing to someone not yet doing life with Jesus! -Matthew


