Sometimes You Have to Get Lost to Find Your Way!

Have you ever been lost? If so, you discovered it can be one of the most disarming, debilitating, disconcerting, disturbing, and dreadful states of mind and body in which to find yourself!

You've lost your sense of direction, you've lost your sense of purpose, you've lost your sense of place, you've lost your bearings, you don't know where to turn, you are totally confused. If you don't solve the problem, you may even lose your mind. You are . . . well . . . LOST!

We are in the middle of a totally unexpected and unplanned for time of being "shut in and shut down" over something unseen by the human eye. Yet, the effects of that invisible dot are being felt in one way or another by every person on the face of the Earth - a round body that is so large it can be seen easily from space! What an ironic and amazing contrast!

This "newest abnormal" is playing a huge number on our sense of direction, our sense of purpose, our sense of place, and our bearings. We don't know which way to turn or how to plan in the midst of all the unknowns now or for the foreseeable future. We are thinking more about a lot of things we don't usually consider. We are reassessing priorities. We are concerned and confused. In effect . . . we're LOST!

How do we find our way again when we discover that we are, indeed . . . LOST!? Our minds can quickly become scattered with thoughts running in circles . . . which often happens when lost! What now? What do I do? It's starting to get dark and I'll be really lost! How do I get out of this mess? Is there any help out there I can trust and believe in? How can I be saved?

May I recommend the Greatest Survival Guide ever written? Though it is penned by many writers, all did so under the inspiration and inerrancy of one Author: God our Creator. He knows all about us, our needs, our struggles, our humanness, our tendency to "get lost in the woods"... the good, the bad, and the ugly! And, in His love, grace, mercy, and ultimate sacrifice, He knows the way out and will lead you to safety not just for now, but forever! That "Survival Guide" is better known as The Holy Bible.

The Book of John, the fourth book in the New Testament, is a great place to start. I encourage you to do so.
