A WORD from CONNECTIONS & LIFEGROUP COORDINATOR



“Huddle up!” That’s a phrase that we hear at pretty much any sports game or practice. I personally love watching huddles during football games. A player hustles in from the sidelines to communicate a play from the coach, or the quarterback gives some quick instructions before the whistle blows for the team to get in formation. It looks so cool when the play is called, or instruction is given, and the players give one clap in unison before the huddle disperses. Huddles also happen before and after games. Last minute reminders are given, the old, “Remember what we practiced,” pep talks. In the case of after game huddles, it is a time of celebration, constructive criticism, or sometimes a promise of many laps that will be run during a future practice.

As we kick-off LifeGroups for a new season, and stay in true football form, let’s huddle up. Just for fun, let’s look at Sunday mornings as the last big practice before the game. Coach (Pastor) Matthew Rogers is showing us game film. Through studying the Bible, we can see and learn what worked and what did not work. He is teaching us the tools to use as we get off the bench and get out in the game. Through God-breathed scripture, we have been given the plays to have a successful season. What Coach Matthew cannot hand us are the relationships that a team needs to gel and work together - the hands and feet, the offense and defense, the dynamic. For a sports team, most of this happens off the field or the court. It is teammates hanging out together outside of practice, it is walking through a tragedy together, or celebrating a life victory.

As I am transitioning into the job of Connections Coordinator and LifeGroup Coordinator, I am burdened for our congregation to find their teams, to get in the huddles together. LifeGroups are the place where we form relationships. We get comfortable and open up with each other and encourage each other. One of our LifeGroup Mamas just had a surgery, and we have been coordinating meals and coming up with ways to bring her joy as she heals. I can look back over the years of meeting as LifeGroups with different families, and they have become our lifelong friends. We have laughed, cried, worked, learned, been convicted, and grown together. I want this for everyone at FCC - these are your people to do life with.

We are looking forward to some new things this year, such as doing service projects together and doing a church-wide study during a specific sermon series. I am so excited to see God work through our LifeGroups this year.
