

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. First Baptist Friendswood has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, First Baptist Friendswood **cannot guarantee that you and/or your child will not become infected with COVID-19**. Further, participation could increase your risk of contracting COVID-19.

Below are the procedures we will be following:

First Baptist Friendswood Travel Protocol

- Parents: please say goodbye at drop off, complete any COVID forms necessary, and keep appropriate distance from others
- After check-in, students are in the church's "bubble"; they will keep appropriate distance from those not going to camp with us
- Face coverings to be worn when/if necessary, depending on the circumstances at the time
- Hand sanitizing required upon entry and exit into vehicles. Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- Vans will have limited capacity
- No food or drink in the van
- No parent or outside visitors once at camp
- Once at camp, no travel outside the camp grounds, except two designated adults as needed for emergencies or food/supplies; will adhere to travel precautions
- Parents may transport students to camp, they must follow the First Baptist Friendswood travel guidelines

We will also perform a COVID-19 assessment at check-in with a parent signature, as well as each day while at camp, which will ask the following questions:

- Are you 65 or older or a high-risk individual as designated by the CDC?
If yes, have you consulted with your primary care provider to make the best decision about traveling?
- Do you have a cough?
- Do you have shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Do you have chills?
- Do you have repeated shaking with chills?
- Do you have muscle pain?
- Do you have a headache?
- Do you have a sore throat?
- Do you have a loss of taste or smell?
- Do you have diarrhea?
- Are you feeling feverish or have had a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit in the last 24 hours?
- Have you taken any fever reducing medication in the last 24 hours?
- Have you traveled out of the state within the last 10 days?
- Have you been in known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

We will also follow any specific protocols that GENERATE has in place while at camp.
