

They are currently part of the Bridge Europe team which ministers to refugees and immigrants in Germany and France. Jeff is supporting the local German church, working with the youth group and refugee boys, as well as tutoring them at the local high school and starting a bicycle workshop aimed at building relationships with refugee families. She also works part-time supporting refugee children through homework help and relationship building. The Allers family also prepares a meal twice a month for a dorm of twenty BFA students.
