Profile of Our Church

Fleetwood Bible Church is a congregation of believers in Jesus Christ that is committed to Bible teaching and serving others. We seek to transform communities and lives through the teaching of God's word, making His love evident to all. As an elder-led church, Fleetwood Bible Church is one of the larger churches within the Missionary Church denomination. Average attendance on a Sunday is about 400 between two worship services (traditional and contemporary) and Sunday School for all ages.

The church building is located just outside of the borough of Fleetwood, which is situated northeast of Reading, PA. The Fleetwood area is primarily a farming community, but there are some large businesses, along with many housing developments.

The Pastoral Staff at Fleetwood Bible Church includes a Senior Pastor, Executive Pastor, and Youth Pastor. Additional paid staff includes Communication Director, Financial Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Office Manager, Office Secretary, and custodial/maintenance staff. There is a six-member Elder Board. Established ministries at Fleetwood Bible Church include Adult Sunday School, Prayer, Community Groups, Community Outreach, Deacon Family Care, Fellowship & Hospitality, Library, Men, Women, Young Adult, Youth, Children, Nursery, Worship Arts, Property, Security, Softball, and World Outreach.

Activities at the church focus on drawing members of the community into the church. These include Wednesday night Awana for youth, Summer Vacation Bible School, Youth and Young Adult groups, and Bible studies for various ages. In addition, special events are routinely scheduled, such as FreeBay (an indoor yard sale in which everything is given at no charge) and an Easter Egg Hunt. In the past two years, events have been sponsored outside the church building in the community. These include outdoor movie nights, summer soccer camp, and summer Wednesday Family Nights at the local park.

Fleetwood Bible Church has established an annual budget for 2020 of nearly \$800,000. This annual budget depends on weekly giving of approximately \$15,000. The church is a strong supporter of missions, both locally and globally, with nearly 17% of the budget allocated to denominational support, community benevolence, and world outreach. Global missionaries are supported in Thailand, Northern Ireland, Kenya, Germany, and Honduras. In addition, local members of Fleetwood Bible Church are sponsored as they pursue career missions work within the U.S and abroad.
