Thank God for his guidance, leadership, and work during the last five years and the season of revitalization Foley UMC has gone through. – “And he who was seated on the throne said, “Behold, I am making all things new.” (Revelation 21:5a)

Mondays Pray for God’s leadership and favor on the vision he has revealed for the next season at Foley UMC; pray for powerful movement of God in and through Foley UMC. – “And I will put my Spirit within you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I am the Lord; I have spoken, and I will do it, declares the Lord.” (Ezekiel 37:14)

Wednesdays Pray for new lead pastor Bill Curtin. Pray for a double portion of God’s Spirit on him as he prepares to lead Foley UMC. “And Elisha said, ‘Please let there be a double portion of your spirit on me.’” (2 Kings 2:9b)

Fridays Pray for God’s leading over what you will give toward the sanctuary project and pray for a powerful display of unity and humility as we offer our gifts to the Lord on Pentecost (May 23). “Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 2:5)

Tuesdays Pray for our four missional focus areas (Transformational Discipleship, the Kids of Foley, Real Life Needs, and The Table); pray that God will use these teams to bring his kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. “Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.” (Matthew 6:10)

Thursdays Pray that God would provide every dollar for Foley UMC to finish the sanctuary project and this season of revitalization. “And I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.” (Luke 11:9)

Saturdays Pray for a Pentecost-like outpouring of God’s Spirit on Foley UMC and the greater Foley community. Pray for an activation of the Spirit in your own life. “And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.” (Acts 4:31)
