

- biblical knowledge
- understanding of how to live the Christian life
- relationship with Christ

Abiding in Christ

- John 15:1-11
- He is the Vine, the source of life.
- We are the branches, receiving our spiritual vitality by abiding in him.
- As we abide, fruit appears.
- Fruit = Character (Gal. 5), Behavior (Col. 1:10)




Fruitlessness

- Fruitlessness is not good, but can be helpful.
- It is possible to do Christian "ministry" without abiding in the Vine, but it's impossible to make disciples when your soul is running on empty.
- One of the best ways to test our relationship to the Vine is to engage in a spiritual relationship with a fellow struggler.



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The Elements of Discipling Friendships

• Love . . . the Lord & your friend.

• Know . . . your friend & their heart.

· Speak . . . God's word to him.

• Do . . . Help your friend do something with what he learns.

- Love is the foundation of people-transforming ministry.
- Our love is rooted in and made possible by the gospel.
- 1 John 4:7–12, 19
- Love is demanding.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:7–8
- Without love, our ministry is nothing (1 Corinthians 13:1–3)
