

## FEBRUARY 7 FOLLOWING WORSHIP-ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

This year's Annual Meeting will be a little different. Because of the

restrictions in numbers allowed to gather, a true "annual congregational meeting" is a physical impossibility. The process session has approved most closely replicates what the normal steps would be. The modifications are designed to afford access to the process by all covenant partners while simultaneously recognizing the COVID restrictions.

Notice of all business and the agenda will be included in the bulletin on January 31. The Annual Report and all business to be transacted will be available on the church's website no later than February 1. If any covenant partner would like to raise business for congregational action, it needs to be submitted to Mary Burgoon Spradley, the clerk of session, in time for notice to be included in the bulletin on January 31. In the event new business is raised at the February 7 meeting, it will be handled at a special called congregational meeting later in February.
