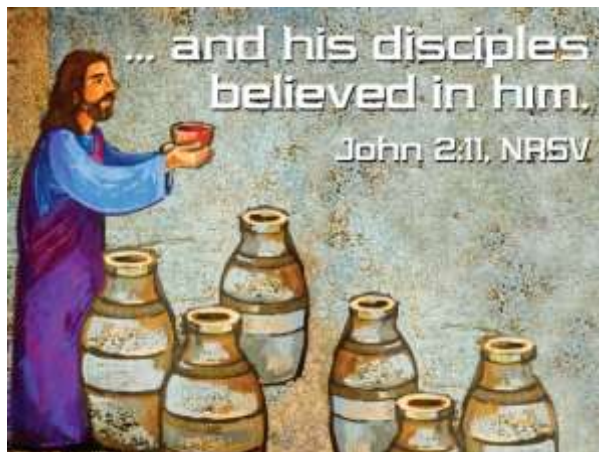



Thank you for helping with this special offering and all of FPC's mission work in 2022.



*The world is Mine, and all that is in it. Ps. 50:12*




1. This is my Fa-ther's world, And to my lis-tening ears
