

# **Belize Mission Trip**

In early March, a mission team from FPC will be leaving for Seine Bight, in southern Belize. We have a lot to do while there: repairing a house (see below), fix-it projects around the church, participating in a women's retreat, and children's ministry, but most importantly - sharing God's love. We also hope to take much-needed clothing that the church will then give away to those in need.

**How can you help?** First and foremost, please pray for the success and safety of the mission trip. Second, please consider donating new or almost new children and adult summer clothing. Items that are especially needed include:

- T-shirts of any size, especially teenage boys and men sizes, and tank tops for men;
- Infant clothing;
  - T-shirts for children and women but (no tank tops);
- Flip-flops of all sizes (we hope to take 100 pairs);
  - Running shoes, for ages 10 to 17, for the running club which is organized by the youth pastor.
